

Search grants.gov for opportunities.
SBA will help with business loans and microloans (sometime no-interest)

Assessing your readiness, choosing a business structure, market research and writing a business plan.

3. Registering your business with the government

Registering or incorporating your business, plus how to apply for a business number or tax account.

Getting business support and financing

National and regional business support, including financing for immigrant and aboriginal entrepreneurs. Selecting a good name, checking if a name is taken, registering and protecting your business name.

Applying for business permits and licences

Permits and licences that you may need for your business from all three levels of government.








Census – NAICS Codes



North American Industry Classification System










to the government or SubNet to find subcontracting Search for existing contracts (USAspend) or the data for contracts over \$10K (FPDS)










GSA – Small Business







Owned and controlled by U.S. citizens who are economically and

Must be a service-disabled

veteran (SDV) or a caregiver and who owns and control 51% or more of business and primarily managed by one or more women who are U.S. citizens

HubZone Small Business

Women-Owned Small Business

Business must be located in an area designated as a Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) Zone

51% or more of business is owned, controlled,

Unique Entity Identification (UEI) – used to need a DUNS number Search for federal contract opportunities (open and recently closed)



Dynamic Small Business Search


The Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS) is a database that government agencies use to find small business contractors for upcoming contracts. Small businesses can also use DSBS to find other small businesses to work with.

SBA maintains the DSBS database. The information you provide when you register your business in the System for Award Management (SAM) is used to populate DSBS, so you should create a comprehensive business profile.

• Find other businesses who do business with the government for

comparison or contact information

- Sell products to other businesses within your industry
- Find awardees who received specific grant funds for marketing purposes
 - Find grant recipients (state, county, city) to find further information on projects for contract opportunities
